Board Meeting Minutes
July 19, 2018

A regular Board meeting of the Crooked River Ranch Rural Fire Protection District Board of Directors took place on Thursday, July 19, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Crooked River Ranch Fire District Fire Station, located at 6971 SW Shad Road, Crooked River Ranch Oregon.

Board Meeting Minutes

- 1. Called to Order by Director Bengtson at 6:30 p.m. Directors Bengtson, Dille, Kirk, Meredith and Oakley were present. Also present was Fire Chief, Harry Ward, Assistant Fire Chief, Mark Wilson, Assistant Fire Chief, Sean Hartley and Administrative Assistant, Dana Schulke. Also in attendance, Captain Alysha Delorto, Volunteer Dennis Senko and Paul Hammerquist. Members of the public were Tina Wilson and Patricia Hayes.
- 2. Review of Meeting Agenda Items Agenda was reviewed and there were no other topics to add.
- 3. Approval of the Board Meeting Minutes.
 - **3.1.** June 20, 2017 Board meeting minutes minutes were reviewed by the Board and Director Dille made a motion to approve the June 20th Board meeting minutes as presented, Director Meredith seconded the motion, and all were in favor and the motion passed (5-0).

4. Financial Reports -

- **4.1.** Director Meredith presented the financial report as of the end of June 2018. In the First Interstate Bank general account, there was \$15,085.76. In the First Interstate Bank-Payroll account, we had \$3,024.25. In the Jefferson County Treasury the account balances were: Bond Fund \$12,090.46, Building/Equipment Capital Reserve Fund \$183,404.57, General Fund \$68,588.26, Local Option Levy Fund \$194,694.03. Accounts Receivable there was \$45.00. There were various questions asked by the Board and by Pat Hayes in regards to the Budget Variance. Director Kirk made a motion to approve the June financial report as presented, with updated June financial information to be submitted to the Board by the end of July. Director Dille seconded the motion, all were in favor and the motion passed, (5-0).
- **4.2 Appointment of Board members to sign checks** It was decided that Director Kirk and Director Meredith will sign checks on Thursday, August 9 and Director Meredith and Director Oakley will sign checks on Monday, August 27, 2018.
- 5. Comments from the public none
- 6. Unfinished Business -
 - **6.1 Follow-up discussion on the new Radios** Assistant Fire Chief, Sean Hartley stated Chief Ward attended the 911 user meeting and they are hoping to have our radios to us by the end of July. It is moving forward, and once we have them we will be in the testing mode with them. There was no other information to report at this time.
 - 7. New Business none

- 8. Fire Chiefs Report Chief Ward stated that tomorrow is the first day we can submit our Ballot Measure for the Levy Increase, he is working on that and will get it submitted to Jefferson County. Once we get a ballot measure number, we can get all our printed material out. We are also working on a very nice presentation board to present to clubs and residents. We had a great turn out for the Independence Day celebration and the obstacle course was a huge hit. The students are half- way through their academy. Our Strategic Plan is finished and if the Board has anything they would like to add to it, or any goals, to please let him know as soon as possible. He stated that Standard of Coverage is also finished. Director Dille stated that there are a few spelling and grammar errors that need to be fixed on page 7 of the Strategic Plan. Assistant Chief's Wilson and Hartley had excellent imput for the Standard of Coverage. He stated we are keeping a close eve on the weather as the heat index is rising and no campfires are allowed at this time. We received a generous donation of \$1,000 last fiscal year to put towards our training area in the back of the station. Chief Ward stated that he was able to get an excavator donated for the day to help clear the area before the footers go in for the cement slab. Other fire districts are anxious to see how we are making this training area as they may make an area for their districts as well. Lastly, he stated that we have an Eagle Scout working on remodeling our flagpole area and we will be relocating the bricks and offering new ones for sale. There was no further information to report.
- **9. Operations Report** an operations report was emailed to the Board, by Assistant Fire Chief, Mark Wilson. He added that one of our students, Amy Weddle was accepted into the COCC Paramedic program. There were no further topics to add to the operations report.
- **10.** Correspondence/Recognitions The Board had received a last minute letter from Accuity, LLC stating that our audit will be done next month on August 16th and 17th.

Director Meredith stated that he purchased a new flag for our flagpole which is 4 x 6. Director Bengtson stated that the Annual Report for this year is located in the lobby and looks great.

- Meeting Called to Order by President Senko at 19:15
- Flag Salute
- There were no previous meeting minutes due to secretary was no longer a member of the District. Contact had been made, but no minutes were available.
- Treasurers Report: 2nd quarter \$229.32 from Kroger Fred Meyer Rewards program which puts the SWAFF account at \$2049.74. No checks written out this last quarter. Total in account is \$35165.35 with available money of \$11081.51. Complete report for inspection is available by request from the treasurer.

 posting team for their Memorial Day ceremony to a potluck picnic at the alpaca ranch on
 highway 97 on July 24th at 17:00.
- Committee reports: None
- Old business:
 - Easter egg hunt was discussed. Suggestions included new age groups to assist in some children being "run over" during event. New age group will be 0-2; 3-4; 5-6; 7-9; 10-12. Next year it was decide to reach out for donations to assist in offsetting some of the expenses.  - Easter account balance had been discussed in Treasurers report and Jeff Green made a motion to bring that account balance up to \$500. Marta seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
 - o Fourth of July celebration was discussed. Parade this year will be held on June 30th along with the barn dance. We will need personnel to assist in setting up the booth before the parade and sell our tee shirts and challenge coins. Mark and Pat Hayes to chair the booth committee. It was brought up we did not have many plastic helmets left owned by the district so asked the Chief to check on purchasing some and the Volunteer Association would reimburse the cost out of our dedicated fund for prevention which has \$536.28 in it and has not been used but once in the past five years. Chief agreed to get pricing and get back to Dennis and Mark with costs.

- Reports from staff:
 - Chief Ward: Fire Season

- Trying to get availability of volunteers to staff any needs for Task Force or Conflagration coverage. Please let him know your availability for extended time periods.
- June 18th Mandatory Training
- New 543 is having pump issues and it was thought to be a training issue but turns out there is a problem. Was discussed that personnel need to get familiar with the truck so when the problem occurs they can hopefully resolve it.
- Volunteer stipends were brought up again that volunteers can work evenings and do either 12 hour shifts or 24 hour shifts and will be paid \$100 per 24 hour time worked.
- New students start June 18th which is when the academy starts as well. The Central Oregon Fire group is sponsoring the academy and there is currently 25 students enrolled. Help is needed to teach and manage the academy from all departments.
- July 4th Chief said there is a possibility of putting together the kid's obstacle course.
- Board voted in February to renew the operations levy with a \$0.20 cent per
 \$1000 increase. They will be handing out information brochures at the parade.
- June 20th and June 26th are the two days for Touch-A-Truck event with CRR HOA event. Volunteers are needed to help with this.

Good of the Order items

- Oregon Fire Service Honor Guard had its annual meeting and training on May 9th and 10th at the OFCA conference located at Eagle Crest.
- The fire located on Cinder Cone Loop used about 5000 gallons of water. Turnout of personnel was just enough to handle the fire and then a medical call as the fire was being mopped up.
- Discussion of new "run cards" to assign the proper apparatus to respond to fires and IOB's. Use 543 as initial response for smoke investigations and possible IOB's and use heavies for all other brush fires. Do not take 522 unless it is necessary.
- Do not pay attention to the "rating" of the fire from Dispatch of high or low risk levels.
 This has to do with staffing of fire fighters in Bend and has no effect on any other department. All our fires are high risk due to our available personnel.
